What is Legal Aid?

Legal Aid offers free, comprehensive, civil legal services to low-income families and individuals in Greater Cincinnati and Southwest Ohio. We operate as an Ohio nonprofit 501c3 corporation.

Our mission is to resolve serious legal problems of low-income people, to promote economic and family stability, and to reduce poverty through effective legal assistance.




What is Legal Aid?

In 2024, Legal Aid received over 20,000 requests for assistance. Legal Aid resolves civil legal cases such as solving housing issues for both renters and homeowners, clearing barriers to employment, stabilizing incomes, and securing safety for survivors of abuse.

In 2024, our attorneys and paralegals represented families in more than 10,000 individual cases assisted by 175 private attorneys who took cases pro bono through the affiliate Volunteer Lawyers Project.
